Matt Lewis is an author and historian of the Middle Ages, with a particular focus of the Wars of the Roses and King Richard III. Always seeking to return to contemporary source material, Matt has written biographies of Richard III, his father Richard, Duke of York, and Henry III along with accounts of the Wars of the Roses and the Anarchy.

Since 2021, Matt Lewis is also Chairman of the Richard III Society.

His talk centres on the fate of the Princes in the Tower. It is one of histories' most famous and enduring mysteries. The sons of King Edward IV vanished in the summer of 1483, and the identity of their murdered has been hotly debated ever since. In this talk, Matt Lewis poses a different possibility. What if we've been asking the wrong question for centuries? What if we should stop looking for a murderer in 1483, and instead start talking about the survival of the Princes in the Tower?
